

Communalytic is a research tool for studying online communities and online discourse.

Communalytic can collect and analyze public data from social media platforms. It uses advanced text and social network analysis techniques to automatically pinpoint toxic and anti-social interactions, identify influencers, map shared interests and the spread of misinformation, and detect signs of possible coordination among seemingly disparate actors.



A network representation of replies to a given tweet










Precedence of AND before OR

One key difference to keep in mind when using operators with the new recent search and filtered stream endpoints is that

- In the old v1.1 API (search/tweets), OR is applied before logical AND(which is denoted by a space between terms or operators)
- . In the new Twitter API (recent search and filtered stream), AND is applied before OR


Twitter's Advanced Search Operators: Filter by Tweet Type



- This operator specifies a circular geographicarea to match geo-coded tweets that fall within that area
- Define a central an-lat coordinate, and then set the radius (up to 25 miles).
